

Former Blackhawks in College – Labor Day 2011 Roundup

Division I

Zac Brown, a sophomore, is on the roster as a goalie for the Richmond Spiders, but did not see playing time in either of Richmond's first two games.

Luc Bruggeman, a sophomore, is on the roster as a midfielder for the Lafayette Leopards, but did not see playing time in either of the Leopards first two games.

Karim Darbaki, a sophomore, is on the roster as a midfielder/forward for the Northern Illinois Huskies. He started in their first two regular season games, getting two assists among the four goals the Huskies scored in beating St. Louis 2-1 and beating Oakland 2-1.

Lawrence Talery, a sophomore, is on the roster as a midfielder for the Univ. of Wisconsin Green Bay Phoenix. He played 41 minutes in the first game, a 1-0 win over Southern Illinois.
