Frequently Asked Questions

Q. When and how will I find out which team my player is on?

A. All players will receive an email by April 2nd. Please contact your age group coordinator if you have not heard from the club by April 2nd.

Q. Can my player play up an age level?

A. Playing in an older age group must be approved by the Blackhawks club directors. Exception: U8's can play up at a U9 level.

Q. What additional items will my team manager collect after my player has been assigned to a team?

A. After team formation, team managers will collect a player photo for MYSAs player passes, a medical liability form, birth certificate, uniform orders and payments, and tournament fees.

Q. How can I volunteer?

A. Blackhawks Soccer Club needs many volunteers to be successful. Being a team manager is the most common volunteer position. Team Managers receive a \$100 discount on registration fees. Note: team managers pay the full fee when they register; the club will reimburse. Other volunteer opportunities include Age Group Coordinator, serving on the Board of Directors and team fundraising.

Q. When and how often will teams practice?

A. The season begins with Age Group Training on Saturdays starting March 31. Team practices, usually one or two per week, begin early in April and run through the season. MYSAs league games (one or two per week) are scheduled between April 30 and July 9.

Q. What is Age-Group Training?

A. Organized by our professional coaching staff, the age-group training sessions emphasize skill & technical development in a fun, learning environment. Age-Group Training will be held Saturdays, March 31, April 14, 21 and 28 (no session on April 7).

Q. What should my player bring to practice and age-group training?

A. Players need soccer cleats and indoor shoes, soccer ball (size 4), water bottle, and shin guards.

Q. Do teams play in tournaments?

A. Each team chooses which tournaments to play in. Most teams play in 1-2 tournaments during the season in the Twin Cities area. Tournaments are held on weekends and run from Friday evening through Sunday afternoon.
